

Stages of Formation as a Poor Clares of Perpetual Adoration

Becoming a nun is a journey with the Holy Spirit taking time and experience. It is an ever-deepening relationship between the one discerning, the Community and our Eucharistic Lord.

I. POSTULANCY

After her initial time of contact and visits with the Community, the next step is her year of postulancy where she deepens her appreciation of her baptismal consecration and the fundamental elements of Christianity.

III. TEMPORARY PROFESSION

In the period of temporary vows she progresses toward further maturity and prepares for the complete gift of herself to God through perpetual profession.

II. NOVITIATE

The Novitiate is a foundational period in the path of formation becoming "deeply rooted in a life with Christ"; a time of transition into our charism of Adoration and thanksgiving, of poverty and silence, and of a chaste and obedient love.

IV. SOLEMN PROFESSION

Until death, she continues to deepen her knowledge of God, her commitment to her vows, and her love of our Eucharistic Lord. This is a never-ending journey as God always provides something new in His relationship with His Beloved.
